

Who and What ARE we, really?

Spirit in Man, Part 2 of 2

Summary: *New sermon, part 2 to the Spirit in Man message about what we humans really are. Here we answer: “How does God stir people up? What happens when a loved one dies? Does anything go to God in heaven – or not? What happens when someone is resurrected from the dead? What will be going on in the first resurrection to glory and spirit life? What about Ezekiel 37 and the valley of Dry Bones? All this and more.*

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(Note: I say Yehovah or YHVH in the Old Testament scriptures that speak of “the LORD”, as YHVH is what is accurate. There’s no “the” in our God’s name. I also sometimes say the Hebrew name “Yeshua” instead of the Anglicized name Jesus.)

Greetings, family members of God’s household and friends around the world.

This sermon is Part 2 of the Spirit in Man topic. Please listen and study Part 1 first.

My grandsons and I love nature films - but whenever they speak of man as the highest order of “animals”, I cringe. I know that humankind, made in the image of God, and given dominion over the animal kind, is not an animal. We have flesh and blood and bones as they do, but we have a MIND that they do not have and we have a special spirit in us from God that animals do not have. So we are NOT animals. We are humans created in the image and likeness of God himself.

This “Spirit in man” (SIM) topic is such an important topic because without it, people get all mixed up about death and life after death, and so on. But understanding the Spirit in man will also give us better insight into the resurrection and so much more.

OPENING PRAYER

REAL QUICK RECAP/REVIEW

Last time we covered some key verses:

Genesis 2:7 – YHVH God formed man out of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living being (or soul”).

Adam was a mere clay vessel until YHVH blew the breath of life into him.

James 2:26– “**For as the body without the spirit is DEAD...**”

Job 32:8 – “there is a spirit in man, and the breath of the Almighty gives him understanding.”

And **1 Cor. 2:9-11** tells us that we have ability to reason and think and plan as a human, because of our spirit in man - - something cows, apes and crows don't have. *The Spirit in man is what makes us different from animals.*

I believe the SPIRIT IN MAN records and contains our DNA, everything we've seen and heard, our memory and experiences, our “heart and soul”, everything that makes you – YOU.

Our Creator knew you while you were still in the womb (Psalm 139:13-16). He says of some of us, maybe all of us, that He knew us even BEFORE we were formed in the womb (**Jeremiah 1:4-5**). In the last sermon I gave all the scriptures for that, including “those he predestined, he foreknew” in Romans 8:29, “to be conformed to the image of His Son”.

God gave life in the womb equal value as adult life (see Ex. 21:21-25).

Our present lives are called TENTS, earthen vessels (2 Cor. 4:7; 2 Peter 1:13-14; 2 Cor. 5:1-2).

Our bodies are not our real main selves, but our real self is really the Spirit in man.

So what IS the Spirit in man (S.I.M.)?

- It apparently is a form of SPIRIT essence from God in us that mankind cannot capture or put into a bottle or something.
- The spirit in man is not God's Holy Spirit.
- *The SIM is the record of the real you and me. It comes from God and goes back to God.* Our earthly bodies are not the real you and me, as the clay vessels that we are simply turns back to dust after we die.
- The SIM is what makes us humans instead of animals. It gives us minds and intellect. It is what makes us different from the animal kind.
- I also see the SIM as **the spirit interface God put into each of us** to allow him to interact easily with us by His spirit, as you'll see.

When God stirs up our spirit

By having the spirit in man, **God can use HIS spirit to stir individuals or even groups to do a particular thing.** *God has moved the course of history to his will this way many times. When you have a “gut feeling” about something,* that could well be your SIM (spirit in man) being stirred by God. Sometimes it is referred to God putting a notion or thought into someone's heart.

I think this is what's happening when we read that God hardened Pharaoh's heart (Exodus 9:12; 14:8). But now let's read specific verses about God using our Spirit to his purpose. He used it to stir up world rulers to do His bidding.

1 Chronicles 5:26

“So the God of Israel stirred up the spirit of Pul king of Assyria, that is, Tiglath-Pileser king of Assyria. He carried the Reubenites, the Gadites, and the half-tribe of Manasseh into captivity. He took them to Halah, Habor, Hara, and the river of Gozan to this day.”

Cyrus – to allow Jews to return back to Jerusalem and rebuild the Temple

2 Chronicles 36:22-23 to CYRUS -- REBUILD the temple

Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of YHVH by the mouth of Jeremiah might be fulfilled, YHVH stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, so that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and also put it in writing, saying,

23 Thus says Cyrus king of Persia:

All the kingdoms of the earth YHVH God of heaven has given me. And He has commanded me to build Him a house at Jerusalem which is in Judah. Who is among you of all His people? May YHVH his God be with him, and let him go up!”

Haggai 1:14-15

“So YHVH stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and **the spirit of Joshua** the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, **and the spirit of all the remnant of the people;** and they came and worked on the house of YHVH of hosts, their God, 15 on the twenty-fourth day of the sixth month, in the second year of King Darius.”

Ezra 7:27

“Blessed be YHVH God of our fathers, who has put such a thing as this in the king's heart, to beautify the house of YHVH which is in Jerusalem...”

2 Corinthians 8:16

“But thanks be to God who puts the same earnest care for you into the heart of Titus.”

So now it's getting more interesting, and you can see why I call the SIM the “Interface” to God so he can so easily work with us as clay in his hands.

What happens when people die?

What happens at DEATH? God says, in many, many scriptures that he considers our death as a temporary state of SLEEP. When we are fast asleep, we are not aware of

anything going on around us. To God, when we die, HE has our spirit – and as far as he's concerned, we are just asleep. Yeshua said that about Lazarus – that he "slept", when he was dead (**John 11:11-15**).

This next passage written by Solomon, reflects his cynicism with life, as he began to wander from Yehovah, but he addresses the spirit in man:

Ecclesiastes 3:19-22

"For what happens to the sons of men also happens to animals; one thing befalls them: as one dies, so dies the other. Surely, they all have one breath; man has no advantage over animals, for all is vanity. 20 All go to one place: all are from the dust, and all return to dust. 21 **Who knows the spirit of the sons of men, which goes upward, and the spirit of the animal, which goes down to the earth?**"

Solomon zeroes in on what "goes upward" means later in Ecclesiastes.

Ecclesiastes 12:7

"Then the dust will return to the earth as it was,
And the spirit will return to God who gave it."

So when our spirit in man leaves us, we die. James 2:26 again – "as the body without the spirit is dead..." I used to believe we should just say a person "died" – and not the terms like "departed, passed on, passed away" – but there IS a departure that takes place at death. Our spirit does depart and goes back to God in heaven who gave it.

So something DEPARTS! It's our SPIRIT that goes back to God. It's the SPIRIT that is the real you and me and makes the real you and me ALIVE. When that spirit in us leaves, our life leaves. Again, I'm not speaking about the Holy Spirit of God, but what the Bible calls the Spirit in man. Yeshua knew this and Stephen the first martyr after Christ, knew this. Look what Christ says as he was dying:

Luke 23:46

"And when **Jesus** had cried out with a loud voice, He said, 'Father, 'into Your hands I commit My SPIRIT.' Having said this, He breathed His last."

Remember that even Jesus – Yeshua – is ALSO God – so He also can receive our Spirit. (Yeshua is also God – see these scriptures Heb. 1:8, John 1:1-3)

Acts 7:59-60

And they stoned Stephen as he was calling on God and saying, "**Lord Jesus, receive my SPIRIT.**" Then he knelt down and cried out with a loud voice, "Lord, don't charge them with this sin." And when he had said this, he fell **asleep.**" (He died).

And what do you think happens when a dead person is brought back to life?

Even the expression "brought back to life" gives a clue. We read a similar account when God let Elijah resurrect the dead son of a woman:

1 Kings 17:21-22

And he stretched himself out on the child three times, and cried out to Yehovah (YHVH) and said, "O YHVH my God (Elohim), I pray, **let this child's soul**

(nephesh- life) come back to him." 22 Then Yehovah heard the voice of Elijah; **and the soul (life) of the child came back to him, and he revived.**"

Extra not in the audio: Yeshua resurrected the daughter of Jairus, after saying she was only sleeping (Luke 8:52-53). Let's continue:

Luke 8:54-55

But He put them all outside, took her by the hand and called, saying, "Little girl, arise." **55 Then her spirit returned, and she arose immediately.** And He commanded that she be given something to eat."

So God, Yeshua, the apostles – referred to death as a SLEEP. A temporary unconsciousness. The person in the deep sleep isn't solving trigonometry problems or framing a house! They're not aware. So our spirit departs – we die – but it's considered temporary by God and we're in a state similar to a very deep sleep. And if God sends BACK the spirit of the one who recently died, he or she comes back to life!

Remember, though his SPIRIT went back to God the Father, Yeshua still needed to be resurrected and his spirit put back into a new body. Remember a spirit being can appear as a normal human, can eat, can appear and disappear at will.

A SPIRIT can appear as a man or woman or animal or anything it wants to appear as – even fire, or anything. When appearing as a human, the spirit being can choose to do that and will now eat and drink and stand and walk and talk as a human. Many angelic appearances confirm this.

Even Christ, after his resurrection, when appearing to the disciples appeared as a man with flesh and bones – at will. But flesh and bones can't appear suddenly through locked doors and walls, and then disappear at will. But when Yeshua said, "LOOK – feel my hands, my bones, my flesh" – at that moment he was appearing as a man, APPEARING as a mortal. **(Luke 24:36-39).** But then he disappeared again! So what does that tell you? Let's read it.

John 20:17-29

Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, '**I am ascending to My Father** and your Father, and to My God and your God.'"

18 Mary Magdalene came and told the disciples that she had seen the Lord, and that He had spoken these things to her.

19 **Then, the same day at evening, being the first day of the week,** when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled, **for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in the midst,** and said to them, "Peace be with you." 20 When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord.

21 So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you." 22 And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. 23 If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

24 Now **Thomas**, called the Twin, one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. 25 The other disciples therefore said to him, "We have seen the Lord." So he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe."

26 And after eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus came, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, "Peace to you!" 27 Then He said to Thomas, "Reach your finger here, and look at My hands; and reach your hand here, and put it into My side. Do not be unbelieving, but believing." **28 And Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"** 29 Jesus said to him, "Thomas, because you have seen Me, you have believed. Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

So do "WE" go to heaven consciously when we die?

Now this SPIRIT that returns to God is not the living, thinking being, as far as we can tell, if we're honest with scripture. The "conscious being" who died does not go to heaven, just his spirit does. I say this because Yeshua said NO ONE has ever ascended to heaven. But the Spirit in mankind that goes back to God at death is some kind of exact record of you, but it's not in an active, thinking, and interacting conscious form of you up there.

John 3:12-13 Holman translation

"If I have told you about things that happen on earth and you don't believe, how will you believe if I tell you about things of heaven? 13 **NO ONE has ascended into heaven except the One who descended from heaven—the Son of Man.**"

You'd think if anyone was in heaven, it would be King David. But what did Peter say about David? Please read the whole context of his sermon in Acts 2. I'll pick up in Acts 2:29, 34.

Acts 2:29-36

"Men and brethren, **let me speak freely to you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried**, and his tomb is with us to this day. 30 Therefore, being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that of the fruit of his body, according to the flesh, He would raise up the Christ to sit on his throne, 31 he, foreseeing this, spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ, that His soul was not left in Hades, nor did His flesh see corruption.

32 This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses. 33 Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He (Christ) poured out this which you now see and hear.

34 "For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he says himself:

"YHVH said to my Lord, sit at My right hand,

35 Till I make Your enemies Your footstool."

36 "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ."

So David died, he is buried, the conscious David ceased to exist, he is in a deep sleep – as God describes death—awaiting his resurrection. But his SPIRIT IN MAN went to heaven, back to God who gave it, but David still awaits the resurrection and his new glorious body, which we'll describe in more detail in a few minutes.

But David's fleshly body, the "earthen vessel", the house of clay, the temporary TENT – as various ones described our bodies – had gone into corruption.

Acts 13:35-37

Therefore He also says in another Psalm:

'You will not allow Your Holy One to see corruption.'

36 "For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, **fell asleep, was buried with his fathers, and saw corruption**; 37 but He whom God raised up saw no corruption.

Someone in a deep sleep is not aware of what's going on. So though the spirit in man is with God in heaven, there's no planning, no thoughts, no brain function going on.

Psalms 146:3-4

"Do not put your trust in princes,
Nor in a son of man, in whom there is no help.

**4 His spirit departs, he returns to his earth;
In that very day his plans perish."**

Remember we read Yeshua's own words that NO one has ascended to heaven where God lives. **NO one. John 3:13** – that's according to Yeshua himself. No one means not even Enoch and Elijah – or else Jesus would have been lying! And of course that's preposterous. So how do we explain Enoch and Elijah?

What about ENOCH and ELIJAH?

Though I had prepared a full explanation, I will save that for a coming BLOG on the subject instead – or I'll run out of time in this message.

I'll just say this: We're told Elijah went up to "heaven" in a whirlwind (NOT in a fiery chariot as so many tell the story) (**2 Kings 2:11**). There are three heavens mentioned in scripture. Whirlwinds/tornadoes operate in the first heaven – our atmosphere where clouds form, where birds fly. There are no whirlwinds where the stars are or where God's throne is.

Yeshua said NO ONE has gone up to the 3rd heaven where God is, so Elijah did not go up there. In fact we find out that many years later, Elijah is writing a letter to a later king, condemning his evil reign (**2 Chronicles 21:12-13**).

And as far as Enoch goes, scripture nowhere says he went to heaven. He wasn't "found" that he would not see death. **Genesis 5:24; Hebrews 11:5**. But Enoch and all the prophets and patriarchs and matriarchs "ALL DIED" – yes, including Enoch (**Hebrews 11:13**).

THE FIRST RESURRECTION IS TO A SPIRIT BODY

The spirit in man that goes back to God *still needs a body* when it comes back to life, either back into a flesh and blood body, as in the case of Lazarus and others brought back to life – or into a glorious spirit body at the FIRST resurrection (**Revelation 20:5; Daniel 12:2-3**).

Scripture calls the first resurrection to glory – the “BETTER resurrection” (**Hebrews 11:35**). Revelation 20:5 calls this the FIRST resurrection.

Hebrews 12:22-24

*But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels, 23 to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, **to the spirits of just men made perfect**, 24 to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than that of Abel.*

Those in the first resurrection are those being called to be first fruits, as we've discussed many times before. The holydays of God depict the sequence of events when God Most High chooses to call us to the high calling of being the *first* of those resurrected, after Christ, and to be brothers and sisters of Christ, and literal Children of God (**2 Cor. 6:18**).

We receive his seed – *His Spirit* – that puts the very holy presence and glory of God himself into our bodies, and *we become the holy temple* of God himself (**1 Corinthians 3:16**). Inside us is God's very own Holy Spirit now.

Romans 8:14-17

“For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. 15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." **16** The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit ***that we are children of God, 17 and if children, then heirs — heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ***, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.”

Those who are part of this process are described as being ***“in Christ”***.

There's also an intriguing verse I don't have time to go deeply into – 1 Cor. 6:15-17 – that he or she “*Who is joined to the Lord, is ONE SPIRIT with the Lord*” (v. 17) – and the context is in the same way that a man and woman who come together in sexual union are ONE FLESH, somehow we become ONE SPIRIT with the Messiah! Go read it.

In this process we receive a godly heart – a new spirit nature, God's own spirit – that is at war with the spirit we had and fleshly nature we already have. See Gal. 5:16-18.

Verse 17-- The fleshly nature we have desires what is against the Spirit, and vice versa; they're at war, so we end up doing what we don't really want to do. Those who repent, accept Yeshua as their Lord and Savior and overcome the fleshly nature *by* Christ's power and nature in us, and who accept the righteousness of God by faith -- will be in the first resurrection.

So when we die, our SPIRIT IN MAN goes to God who gave it (Ecc. 12:7). It has no plans, no thoughts (**Psalms 146:3-4**) but is a complete record of everything that makes you – you. But your spirit is in God's total care awaiting the resurrection – and in the case of God's children, to *a “better resurrection”* of an immortal GLORIOUS spirit body.

WHAT KIND OF BODY will we have in the first resurrection to glory?

What kind of BODY will you have? What will you BE like? What will you LOOK like?

1 John 3:1-3

“Behold what manner of love **the Father** has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. 2 **Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, WE SHALL BE LIKE HIM,** for we shall see Him as He is. 3 And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.”

SO what happens? How does that happen?

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

13 But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. 14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, **even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. (He explains this in vs 15-17)**

15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the *Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep.* 16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. **And the dead in Christ will rise first.** 17 **Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them** in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. 18 Therefore comfort one another with these words.”

THIS is the time when God our Father shall put our spirit in man, now made perfect and totally righteous by faith, into a glorious new spirit body that will never fade away. A spirit body that is powerful, will never age, will never have pain, will never be sick – but gloriously powerful. With a mind that has no limits in its capabilities. With a glory that will outshine the sun, when we desire it to (Daniel 12:2-3).

Again, as we pointed out last time, the real YOU is not the aging flesh and blood body you have now, a body that will someday die and go back to dust. I don't know about you... but parts of MY body are either falling apart, falling out, sagging or just plain not working – and it hurts too much too. Lol.

How about you and your body? OK, I speak to you who are in your 60's or older, or over 65 maybe. I want a new body....but not a flesh and bone and blood body, but a new spirit body.

So the real you and real me is not the body you and I see when we look at each other! Thank God! The real you is what's inside you, your spirit in man, your spiritual heart – the essence that is everything “YOU”, unique to YOU. There's not a single other life out there that is exactly like you.

1 Corinthians 15:35-55

35 But someone will say, "How are the dead raised up? And with what body do they come?" 36 Foolish one, what you sow is not made alive unless it dies. 37 And what you sow, you do not sow that body that shall be, but mere grain — perhaps wheat or some other grain. 38 But God gives it a body as He pleases, and to each seed its own body.

39 All flesh is not the same flesh, but there is one kind of flesh of men, another flesh of animals, another of fish, and another of birds.

40 There are also celestial bodies and terrestrial bodies; but the glory of the celestial is one, and the glory of the terrestrial is another. 41 There is one glory of the sun, another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars; for one star differs from another star in glory.

42 So also is the resurrection of the dead. The body is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption. 43 It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness, it is raised in power.

44 It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body. 45 And so it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.

46 However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural, and afterward the spiritual. 47 The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from heaven.

48 As was the man of dust, so also are those who are made of dust; and as is the heavenly Man, so also are those who are heavenly. 49 And as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly Man.

50 Now this I say, brethren, **that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God**; nor does corruption inherit incorruption.

51 Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but **we shall all be changed — 52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.**

53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

54 So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, **and this mortal has put on immortality**, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory."

55 "O Death, where is your sting?
O Hades, where is your victory?"

Daniel was inspired to write that our new bodies will shine like the SUN in full strength!
(Daniel 12:2-3)

There's more I would like to cover on this topic, but let it suffice to say that knowing these things, let be sure to make our calling and election by God – SURE! Let's give all due diligence to be growing and overcoming and becoming more and more like our Savior (**2 Peter 1:5-9** – please read this).

2 Peter 1:10-11 Holman Bible

"Therefore, brothers, make every effort to confirm your calling and election, because if you do these things you will never stumble. 11 For in this way, entry into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ will be richly supplied to you."

NKJV: "...to make your calling and election SURE..."

Now later on, those who are brought back to life after the thousand year reign, will all be resurrected into mortal fleshly bodies, **as Ezekiel 37 tells us** in the story of the Valley of the Dry bones. You should read it – especially **Ezek 37:1-14**. Bone upon bone. In there you read that Yeshua the Word, who is also God, calls them from the grave and puts flesh and breath into them – and they shall LIVE. And he also promises to put His Spirit into them and they shall live (v. 14). Remember the actual creation of all things has always been by the Word of God – who became flesh – and we know him as Jesus Christ or Yeshua the Messiah (**John 1:1-3, 14; Eph 3:9; Heb 1:2**).

HOW do they live again?

God puts their SPIRIT IN MAN that he has been storing with him, back into new flesh and blood bodies and life and breath are restored. Now they also can have a real shot at learning about God, about understanding the Bible because they now have his very own Spirit of GOD in them as well as their human spirit in man.

SO – much of the teaching of scripture really revolves around the human spirit and God's spirit coming together to form the new man and new woman in Christ.

So GUARD your spirit. Enclose it with the very spirit of God. Fight the good fight of faith and resist the Devil, draw near to God, fight temptations of the flesh—and don't look back to your sinful past. Christ (**Luke 9:62**) and Paul say to NOT look back, to forget those things which are behind us (**Philippians 3:13**) but to look up and forward to our high calling. ALL our evil sins of the past have been washed away in the blood of our Savior if we repented and accepted him (**1 John 1:7-9**).

And when or if we die, the first words we'll hear will be the SHOUT of victory from Christ himself, and then the voice of the arch angel and the trumpet of God, calling us from the grave to everlasting life.
